I am Jasmine's mom, and proud to have been for 14 year and 2 months. A beautiful blue creme Persian with a gentle and loving personality. She loved to sit on you anytime you sat still. She loved to eat your ice cream and cereal milk, and she would talk to you when you came home. However, I believe, she, too, was killed by tainted food - the food she ate every single day for months. In fact, I still have the food in my pantry just wondering if I should have it tested.

In mid February 2007, I began noticing Jasmine sat at the water dish a lot more than normal. She also seemed to be losing weight as her appetite didn't seem normal. Because she's a Persian, her eyes would produce a discharge and this was normal, however it was heavier, thicker, and more frequent. <o:p></o:p>

On February 20, Jasmine began just lying for long periods. Her breath smelled "deadly" and a funny black substance was coming from her mouth. As the week went on, she began drinking water from places like the toilet or sink or shower floor. She didn't want to be picked up, or loved on. She began howling and her urine smelled foul as did her beautiful blue creme fur. All very unusual behavior for her.<o:p></o:p>

The night of Feb 23, having once been through renal failure with my son Gantz, also a Persian, it occurred to me she was very sick. The howling became worse, and more frequent. She still was not eating, and now she was not urinating either. So on Feb 24, I rushed her to a local animal hospital. While he was friendly and concerned, he said she probably had a dental infection which would cause the foul breath, and since she was 14 years old, her kidneys were probably failing. Oh, how I cried and cried. The vet gave us amoxicillin for the "dental infection". For 3 days she

continued on her course of not eating, etc. And on Feb 27, I again rushed her to the local vet. They put her on IV's and antibiotics for the day but did not have overnight care, so I rushed her to our family vet that lived much further away as I knew their facilities were better equipped. The Pet Care staff was so good to me and my 2 daughters, 12 & 7. We were all basket cases with fear and then grief. Jasmine's blood results showed her kidneys had completely shut down, and it was "time". Oh how painful, and all of this in only one short week. Jasmine weighed only 4.5 pounds when she died and had been 11 pounds approximately one year prior. <o:p></o:p> Nothing will bring her back - nothing.
